



Tryout Day Information

Please review our tryout day process. This will help you and your daughter understand what to expect the day of tryouts.

What to bring?

1. **Copy** of the athlete's birth certificate that we can keep for our records for USAV and AAU reporting purposes.
2. A check for the \$500 deposit. (Credit card on file? That will suffice.) Note: we will process the check if an offer is extended and accepted; we will shred the check if no offer is extended or if the offer is declined. We will process the credit card on file if an offer is extended and accepted.
3. Signed Release of Liability & Participation form located under our forms link. (Everyone must complete a new form each season.)
4. Players should bring water and wear athletic attire and volleyball gear like kneepads, volleyball shoes or athletic shoes, shorts, spandex, leggings, etc. *(Please note the water fountains may be off due to COVID. Please pack ample water.)*

Upon arrival:

1. Please arrive during the designated time for check-in before the tryout start time to allow for time to receive paperwork and a tryout t-shirt. Please do not arrive before the check-in time. 2. If your daughter is experiencing a fever, COVID symptoms, or she is ill with a contagious illness like strep throat, etc., please do not attend tryout. Contact us, and we can help you reschedule a tryout.
3. Parents will receive an electronic tryout packet with the club contract and additional club season details after an offer has been extended and accepted. The club contract will be due within 24 hours of receiving it if an offer is extended and accepted.
4. Players will be given a try-out t-shirt and asked to change their shirt after check-in. Uniform fittings will be scheduled at a later date for players that accept a position with PAVC.
5. Parents are not permitted to stay during tryouts. We will ask all parents to exit once they have completed their daughter's check-in process.

During the tryout:

1. Players will be tasked with completing drills to demonstrate their skills as coaches participate in the evaluation process.

After the tryout:

1. Please pick-up your daughter at the end of the scheduled try-out time. Please aim to pick-up your within 10 minutes of the end of the try-out time frame.
2. Coaches will meet to discuss the tryout and prospective players.
3. **Families will receive an email regarding their daughter's tryout within 24-48 hours after the end of the tryout.** Please check your email in-boxes, promotional email in-boxes, and spam email boxes. My email may go to a spam folder if you do not have my email address saved in your contacts. If you have not received communication after the 48-hour time frame, please email me at precisionathleticstj@gmail.com.
4. Please do not contact PAVC **before** the 48-hour window has expired.
5. If for some reason your email kicks back my initial email due to your inbox being full, etc. Then I will follow-up with a phone call.
