



2022-2023 Tryout Day Information

Please review our tryout day process. This will help you and your daughter understand what to expect the day of tryouts.

What to bring?

1. **Copy** of the athlete's birth certificate that we can keep for our records for USAV and AAU reporting purposes.
2. A check for the \$500 deposit. (Credit card on file? That will suffice.) Note: we will process the check if an offer is extended and accepted; we will shred the check if no offer is extended or if the offer is declined. We will process the credit card on file if an offer is extended and accepted.
3. Signed Release of Liability & Participation form located under our forms link. (Everyone must complete a new form for the 2022-2023 season.)
4. Players should bring water and wear athletic attire and volleyball gear like kneepads, volleyball shoes or athletic shoes, shorts, spandex, leggings, etc. *(Please note the water fountains may be off due to COVID. Please pack ample water.)*

Upon arrival:

1. Please arrive during the designated time for check-in before the tryout start time to allow for time to receive paperwork and a tryout t-shirt. Please do not arrive before the check-in time. 2. Masks are optional for parents and players. However, players with underlying health issues or living with someone that is immune compromised or has underlying health issues are strongly encouraged to wear a mask.
 - a. If your daughter is experiencing COVID symptoms or are ill with a contagious illness like strep throat, etc., please do not attend tryout. Contact us, and we can help you reschedule a tryout.
3. Parents will receive a physical or electronic tryout packet with the club contract and additional club season information. The club contract will be due within 24 hours if an offer is extended and accepted.
4. Players will be given a tryout t-shirt and asked to change their shirt after check-in. Uniform fittings will be scheduled later this summer for players that accept a position with PAVC.
5. Parents are not permitted to stay during tryouts. We will ask all parents to exit once they have completed their daughter's check-in process.

During the tryout:

1. Players will be tasked with completing drills to demonstrate their skills as coaches participate in the evaluation process.

After the tryout:

1. Coaches will meet to discuss the tryout and prospective players.
2. Families will receive an email or phone call regarding their daughter's tryout within 48 hours after the end of the tryout. Please check your voicemails, email boxes, and spam email boxes. 3. Please do not contact PAVC **before** the 48-hour window has expired.
